

Banquet Policies

Food and Beverage: To ensure compliance with County Board of Health food handling regulations, food will be consumed on the premises for the contracted time. Rhythm Kitchen sole provider of all food and beverages served in the banquet facilities. Food and Beverage is not permitted to be brought into building by a guest or any client's guests or attendees. In compliance with Nevada Liquor Laws, Rhythm Kitchen is the only authorized licensee able to sell and serve liquor, beer and wine on the premises. Rhythm Kitchen reserves the right to refuse service to any person who appears to be intoxicated and reserves the right to inspect the identification of any person attending events. No one under twenty-one (21) years of age will be served alcoholic beverages.

Minimum Requirements: Rhythm Kitchen requires a minimum of \$1,500.00 Food and Beverage purchase in order to book the banquet room. If the minimum is not met in the purchase of food or beverages, then the difference will be assessed as a room rental charge to your final bill. For the private room a minimum party size of fourteen (14) is required to rent the space. If the party is under fourteen (14) then accommodations will be made downstairs in the main dining room. Rhythm Kitchen requires a minimum of \$700.00 Food and Beverage purchase in order to book the private room. If this minimum is not met in the purchase of food and beverages then the difference will be assessed as a room rental charge to your final bill.

Room Rental Time Charges: For the banquet room, there are two (2) set up options, as detailed in the Banquet Menu Packages. All packages include use of room for four (4) hours. If event runs longer than the four (4) hours, a room charge of \$150.00 per hour will be assessed. If event is going to last longer than normal operating hours, arrangements must be made prior to event. Rhythm Kitchen has the right to charge additional fees for extending operating hours.

Menu Policies: All event menus must be finalized thirty (30) days prior to event to avoid rush charges. If menu is not finalized, charges will be determined based on menu and will be assessed at Rhythm Kitchen's discretion.

DJ and Live Band Policies: All music must remain under 89Db at all times while the "Electric ChaCha Slide is prohibited from being played. Rhythm Kitchen reserves the right to turn music down and have songs not be played.

Guarantees: Guaranteed number of attendees for all events must be received by the Catering Manager fourteen (14) business days prior to the event. You will be charged the guaranteed number of guests, or the number of people actually served, whichever is greater. If no guarantee is received, the number of guests indicated on the catering event order will be the guaranteed attendance. If the guaranteed number of attendees decreases by more than 15% from the original estimated number of attendance, Rhythm Kitchen reserves the right to charge room rental or relocate your group to a smaller room.

Payment: Rhythm Kitchen requires a non-refundable deposit of \$500.00, in order to reserve area and date. The deposit amount will be applied toward the final bill. Balance of charges based on the anticipated attendance, shall be paid in full by cash, money order, cashier's check or credit card at least three (3) business days prior to the event, or personal checks at least fourteen (14) business days prior to event. Rhythm Kitchen requires a credit card number and completed authorization form on file for any additional charges incurred on the day of the event. If balance of charges has not been received within three (3) days of the scheduled event, we reserve the right to cancel the event, retain the deposit, and the client will still be responsible for the "cancellation charges" specified herein.

Tax and Gratuity: All Food and Beverage prices are subject to an 18% service charge and 8.1% sales tax. Tax-exempt organizations must provide a Certificate of Exemption from the State of Nevada to the Catering Manager upon signing contract. Tax and Gratuity subject to change.

Nevada Clean Indoor Air Act: By Nevada State Law, smoking is prohibited in indoor public spaces. The Nevada Clean Indoor Air Act does not provide exemption for private events; therefore, any person or groups using these areas do not have the option of waving the no smoking regulation for a closed event.

Liability: Organization/Client agrees to protect, indemnify, defend and hold harmless Rhythm Kitchen and its employees and agents against all claims, losses or damage to persons or property, government charges, fines and costs (including reasonable attorney's fees) arising out of or connected with the use of the facilities, including but not limited to the installation, removal, maintenance, occupancy or use of the premises, or any part thereof, by Organization, or any guest, invitee or agent of Organization or any independent contractor hired by Organization, except those claims arising out of sole negligence or willful misconduct of Rhythm Kitchen.
